



## Keyboard Shortcuts

### Interface

Shortcut	Action
<b>Esc</b>	Closes any open windows or menus and focuses on the command line.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + P</b>	Pauses a running script.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + D</b>	Opens the <b>Structure Editor</b> .
<b>Ctrl + Shift + H</b>	Opens the <b>History</b> tab.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + L</b>	Opens the <b>Lexicon</b> tab.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + F</b>	Opens the <b>Databases</b> tab.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + E</b>	Temporarily switches the display mode.

### Global

Shortcut	Action
<b>Shift + ?</b>	Shows / hides the <b>Keyboard Shortcuts Help</b> information.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + C</b>	Opens the <b>Scripts</b> page.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + Y</b>	Opens the <b>Transcripts</b> page.
<b>Ctrl + Shift + S</b>	Opens the <b>Structures</b> page.
<b>Tab</b>	Moves between interface locations.
